RE: CVS Health announces additional COVID-19 resources focused on patient access

Dear Customers,

CVS Health is taking additional steps across the company to address the COVID-19 outbreak and protect patient access to medication.

Beginning immediately, **CVS Pharmacy will waive charges for home delivery of prescription medications.** With the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention encouraging people at higher risk for COVID-19 complications to stay at home as much as possible, this is a convenient option to avoid coming to the pharmacy for refills or new prescriptions.

- Building on a **recent announcement** that COVID-19 diagnostic testing and all telemedicine visits are available with no co-pay, **Aetna will now offer 90-day maintenance medication prescriptions** for Commercial and Medicare members and is working with state governments to make the same option available to Medicaid members where allowable.
- In addition, Aetna will **waive early refill limits on 30-day prescription maintenance medications** for all members with pharmacy benefits administered through CVS Caremark.
